SUMMER CAMPS

Future Stars Football Skills Camp for Rising 2nd-5th Graders

Camp will be held July 10-12, 9 a.m.-12 p.m. at the Everett Athletic Complex. This 3-day camp provides instruction for all offensive and defensive positions, with each camper gaining a better understanding of the football positions through various skills and drills. Camp fee is \$60 and includes a camp shirt. Camp Director is Ricky Upton.

Boys & Girls Track & Field Camp for Kindergarten - Rising 9th Graders

This 3-day camp will be held July 10 -12, 6-8 p.m. at the Maryville Jr. High School Track, led by Maryville High Track Staff. Camp provides instruction related to competing in track and field and focuses on introducing drills/techniques that help develop speed, proper running form, and field events. The fee is \$60 and includes a camp shirt.

Fashion Sewing Camp for Rising 4-8th Graders

A new sewing camp held July 10 -14, 9 a.m.-12:30 p.m. at Springbrook Rec Center, led by instructor Aimee Davis. Campers learn how to make simple garments and fun projects, as well as taking some ready to wear clothes and embellishing/altering them. Campers need to provide a pair of their own blue jeans and 2 blank t-shirts. The \$210 fee includes all supplies except those previously mentioned.

Performing Arts Camp for Ages 10-17

This fun new camp is July 17-21, 9 a.m.-2:30 p.m. at the Everett Recreation Center. Campers learn a variety of performing arts skills taught by professionals in each area, and led by camp director Holly Roe. The daily schedule includes up to 3 different sessions as well as performance opportunities. The \$90 fee includes a camp shirt.

Flag Football for Boys & Girls Ages 6-12

Registration will be July 10 - August 11 (or until full). Games will be played at the Everett Athletic Complex on Sunday afternoons beginning September 10 for an 8-week season. The fee is \$75 and includes a team jersey.
