



POOL REGULATIONS

1. Inclement weather, as determined by the manager, will close the pool.
2. No cut-offs or baggies allowed in pool, for safety reasons first and sanitary reasons. No shirts permitted in pool unless prior approval is obtained from the pool manager. To avoid sunburn, a sunscreen of SPF-25 or higher is recommended.
3. Children eight (8) years of age and younger will ***not*** be permitted in the swimming pool unless they are accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older.
4. Absolutely no "sagging" allowed on pool premises at anytime.
5. Any child not toilet trained **must wear swim diapers**.
6. Food, soft drinks and smoking allowed only in designated areas.
7. Prescription, shatterproof glasses are allowed in pool only by permission of manager.
8. No glass containers allowed inside pool area.
9. Lockers are available. Parks and Recreation Commission is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
10. No toys or valve inflated floats allowed in main pool.
11. Where permitted, only front dives are permitted from the sides of the pool.
12. No masks, fins or snorkels allowed in diving area.
13. All people using the pool slides must go down feet first.
14. No gainers and no cut aways.
15. All life preservers must be approved by the U.S. Coast Guard.
16. Only non-metal toys allowed in baby pool.
17. Baby strollers allowed in baby pool or areas designated by manager only and must be attended at all times.
18. No balls of any type will be permitted in main pool.
19. All actions considered dangerous or offensive are prohibited. (As posted at the pool.)
20. Continuous or flagrant violations of rules may result in removal from the pool and/or cancellation of pool privileges. If necessary, the police will be used to remove unruly patrons. No money will be refunded to season ticket holders whose pool privileges are cancelled.
21. Temporary or permanent suspension from one pool will automatically result in suspension from all Parks and Recreation Commission operated pools for the designated time period.
22. Maryville-Alcoa-Blount County Parks and Recreation Commission reserves the right to close the pool from time to time to provide other aquatics programs. Dates of closings will be posted in advance at each pool.

- 23. If an individual accrues two (2) suspensions, he/she will be suspended for the remainder of the season after the next infraction. ***For flagrant destruction of property, gross and abusive language or physical violence or the threat of physical violence toward any pool employee will result in immediate suspension for a minimum of one (1) month to a maximum of the total balance of the season. No refunds will be made to season ticket holders. Suspension from one pool will apply to all pools operated by Parks and Recreation Commission.***
- 24. ***You must present and surrender your season pass card to the gate attendant each time you visit the pool. Your card will be returned to you when you leave. No one will be admitted without his or her card.***
- 25. Replacement season pass cards may be purchased from the Parks and Recreation Commission for \$5.00.
